1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Nth Brisbane Speedway, Kurri-Kurri Speedway Club, Speedway rider's Assoc, hereafter called the Promoter will conduct Rounds of the 2012 Australian Solo Speedway Championship on the following dates and at the following locations.

Round 2	14 th January 2012	Kurri-Kurri Speedway
Round 3	21 st January 2012	Gillman Speedway

2. JURISDICTION

2.1 The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by MA which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Numbers MA1028, 1029 & 1030, and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Senior National Licences.

2.2 The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's) contained in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by MA. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws and instructions.

3. EVENT OFFICIALS

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Entries are now open and close last mail Friday 9th December 2011. Late entries will not be accepted.

4.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, Rain off days will be 8th, 15th, 22nd January 2012

4.3 Only entries received on the official entry form will be accepted.

4.4 Once entries have been accepted, any rider needing to withdraw from the Championship must do so in writing to Motorcycling Australia.

5. ENTRY FEE

6. ENTRY PASSES

6.1 Each Competitor will receive ONE pass, and two mechanic passes.

7. INSURANCE

7.1 The MA National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

7.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

It is strongly recommended that competitors give consideration to taking out weekly benefits insurance.

8. MEDICAL SERVICES

A road-going Ambulance with Paramedics must be in attendance at all rounds and practices

9. SCRUTINEERING

9.1 Scrutineering will begin at North Brisbane, 1pm – 3pm, Kurri-Kurri, 2pm –3.30pm, Gillman, 3pm – 4.30pm

9.2 Machines entered in the competition must have successfully passed a machine examination prior to taking part in practice, qualifying or racing. An MA decal will be placed on the front number plate to indicate that it has been successfully examined.

9.3 Current competition licences and full riding gear must be presented at scrutineering. Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the meeting. Machines which suffer accident damage in practice or race sessions must be re-examined before participating again.

9.4 In addition to supervising the pulling down and checking of machines after official protests have been received by the Clerk of Course in accordance with the GCRs, the Steward can order that any machine be measured and if this occurs the Scrutineer will supervise a team member to pull down any machine that has taken part in the event. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.

9.5 Machines will not be sealed for later checking after the event. All machines that are to be pulled down and scrutineered will take place at the circuit before the machine is released by the Scrutineer. A member of the rider's team must be available at all times to carry out the strip down under the control of the Scrutineer. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.

10. RACE FORMAT

10.1 The meeting will be run over Twenty (20) heats and Two (2) Finals with Four Rider's in each Heat and Final.

10.2 ALL heats and finals will be over four (4) laps.

10.3 Finals.

Event 22 will be the A Final.

A Final The top three point scorer's will go direct to the A Final plus the winner of the B final.
The place getters in this Final will determine who are 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in the Championship.

B Final Event 21 will be the B Final

The rider's for the B Final will be the 4th – 5th – 6th – 7th point scorer's after 20 heats.

The winner of the B final will go to the A Final, 2nd-3rd-4th in this final will determine who 5th-6th-7th in this meeting.

10.4 If rider's tied on points for the A or B finals, the count back system will determine any ties.

10.5 If rider's are tied on points at the end of the Championship rounds for the first four place getters in the Championship will be decided by a run off.

11. POINTS

11.1 Heat points will be.

First, Three Points (3) Second, Two Points (2) Third, One Point (1), Fourth, 0 Points (0)

13. DRUGS AND ALCOHOL TESTING

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be Nth Brisbane 1pm, Kurri-Kurri 1pm, Gillman 3pm with the completion of the meeting for the participant being 1 hour after the last race has finished.

14. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY

14.1 At each round the first four place getters will receive medallions, The first four place getters in the championship after the three (3) rounds will receive a trophy and sash.

MA Medallions will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd place overall in the Championship, The winner will also be presented with the perpetual "Duke of Edinburgh Trophy". The winner will have their photograph taken with the trophy, and their name will be engraved on it.

14.2 Prize money per round, will be paid after each round by the promoter.

15. GST

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prize money. 16. PRESENTATIONS

Trophy presentation will be held after the A Final at all rounds.

17. MACHINES AND RIDERS

17.1 All machines and rider apparel **MUST** comply with the current GCR's for Speedway Competition.

18. SELECTION OF RIDERS AND STARTING POSITIONS

Selection and starting positions will be carried out by the MA Speedway Commission for all rounds of the Championship at close of nominations on 9th December 2011.

19. RIDERS' BRIEFING

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which **ALL competitors MUST attend**. Details will be included in the final instructions.

20. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION

Round 1: Nth Brisbane Speedway, Raubers Road Northgate Qld, 302 metres Crushed Limestone mixed with river sand.
Round 2: Kurri-Kurri Speedway, Loxford Park 320Metres Dolomite.
Round 3: Speedway Riders Assoc Inc, Gillman Speedway, Wilkins Road Gillman 300Metres Dolomite

21. TRACK WALK

All participating competitors must be given the opportunity to walk the track prior to any on track participation.
If any rider perceives a safety problem with the track, this should be taken up with the Clerk of Course.

22. FACILITIES

Showers, Toilets, Canteens.

23. NOISE

Noise testing may take place at any time at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer or the Clerk of Course. Refer to GCR 12.10 for details.

24. TYRES

Only Two (2) tyres per round permitted. For safety reasons, the referee may allow more tyres if required.

25. ANTI-DOPING POLICY

25.1 All competitors and officials are advised that drug testing may take place in accordance with MA's Anti-Doping Policy, as carried out by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority. Refer to GCR 11 for details.

25.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at MA discretion until the results of the tests are known.

26. ALCOHOL TESTING PROCEDURE

All competitors and officials are advised that random breath-testing may take place during the competition.

27. CODE OF CONDUCT

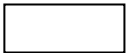

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

2. DEFINITIONS

- In this declaration:
- "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
 - "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
 - "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
 - "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
 - "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
 - "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
 - that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
 - that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
 - that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
 - that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
 - that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/for events;
 - that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
 - that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
 - that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
- the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
- I have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:
- rendered with due care and skill;
- as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
- reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.
Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you.
